1. INTRODUCTION

This online privacy statement (“**Privacy Statement**”) is provided to make you aware of how Calix Limited ABN 36 177 372 540 (“**Calix**”) collects, uses and manages information of visitors to calix.com.au (“**Website**”). Calix, the publisher of the Website, views the personal privacy of users as an important issue, and is committed to maintaining the security of personal information provided to Calix by users accessing the Website. This Policy Statement forms part of the terms of use of the Website (“**Web Terms and Conditions**”) and Calix’s Privacy Policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) and describes how Calix treats personal information that it receives through your use of the Website.

Calix complies with the requirements of the Privacy Act 1988 (“**Privacy Act**”) and the European Union General Data Protection Regulations (“**GDPR**”). Please note: Calix makes some other third party websites available to you from hyperlinks in the Website. These third party websites are not subject to Calix’s Privacy Statement. 2. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND HOW IS IT USED

Calix collects the following information regarding visitors to the Website: domain name and information regarding what pages are accessed. Calix collects and logs this information for statistical purposes. Other than as stated above, no attempt is made to identify you or your browsing activities except, in the event of an investigation, where a law enforcement agency may exercise a warrant to inspect the service provider logs, or where your usage is causing technical issues for our site that may need to be resolved and we need to contact you.

Some sections of the Website may also allow you to contact us by email or otherwise volunteer information about yourself, such as your name, email address, and your preferred means of communication. In addition to the purposes outlined above, this information may be used and disclosed for the purposes of carrying out or responding to your requests, for purposes relating to any third party acquisition of an interest in Calix or its assets, or any other purposes outlined at the time you provided the information. We may not be able to do these things without your personal information.

Calix endeavours to use and disclose your personal information only in limited circumstances. Calix will take all reasonable steps to protect any copyright or intellectual property in the material in the Website, and all reasonable steps to enforce the Calix Web Terms and Conditions. Calix may disclose your personal information to our related bodies corporate and to service providers who assist us in providing the Website and conducting our business including organisations that provide archival, auditing, professional advice, mail house, delivery, recruitment, technology, utility and security

services. Calix may also disclose your personal information to third parties, where you consent to the disclosure or in circumstances where such disclosure is required or authorised by law.

3. COOKIES

A cookie is a small data file that a website may write to your hard drive when you visit them.

A cookie file can contain information, such as a userID, that the Website uses to track the pages you have visited. The only personal information a cookie can contain is information you personally supply. A cookie cannot read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other websites.

The Website may use cookies to track user traffic patterns and to better serve you when you revisit the Website. You can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, providing you with the opportunity to either accept or reject it. You can also refuse all cookies by turning them off in your browser. Please note that some parts of the Website may not function fully for users that disallow cookies.

4. SECURITY

Calix takes all reasonable security measures to protect personal information from loss, unauthorised access, destruction, misuse, modifications or disclosure. Calix will only retain your personal data for as long as it is necessary for the stated purpose and where information held by Calix is no longer required to be held, and the retention is not required by law, then Calix will destroy or delete such personal information by secure means.
